- ✓ Discussion


#### **UC3- Current situation**

# UC3- Significant ideas

✓ UC3 pretends to set the basis for a common agricultural Farm Registry

✓ One of our main goals is to produce a crossborder vocabulary

✓ Unified data to produce standard information

# UC3- Significant ideas (II)

✓ We propose:

- Definitions aligned with EU CAP regulations
- A unique farm identification code that could be used in all MS

 Common code lists in NIVA that will enable us to easily exchange information between participants and with external systems
